

PRIVACY POLICY

INTRODUCTION

This Privacy Policy describes how Vilex and/or Orthex ("Company" or "we" or "us") collects, uses and discloses information that you may provide to us via orthex.net and on the Web-Based Software for the ORTHEX brand fixation device the Website brand fixation device accessible at orthex.net to registered users (collectively, the "Website"). Please read this entire Privacy Policy before using, or submitting information to, the Website to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, your choice is not to use the Website. The Website is intended for use by adults over the age of 18. This Privacy Policy is effective as of Last Modified date shown above and may be amended from time to time.

We respect your privacy and are committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy. This policy applies to information we collect:

- On the Website;
- In e-mail, text and other electronic messages between you and the Website; and
- Through mobile applications, if available, that provide dedicated, non-browser-based interaction between you and the Website.

It does not apply to information collected by:

- Us offline or through any other means, including on any other website operated by Company or our affiliates or subsidiaries; or
- Any third party (including our affiliates and subsidiaries), including through any application or content (including advertising) that may link to or be accessible from the Website.

By accessing or using the Website, you agree to this Privacy Policy. This policy may change from time to time. Your continued use of the Website after we make changes is deemed acceptance of those changes, so please check this Privacy Policy periodically for updates.

INFORMATION WE COLLECT ABOUT YOU AND HOW WE COLLECT IT

We collect several types of information from and about users of the Website, including information:

- by which you, if you are a registered user, may be personally identified, such as name, postal address, e-mail address, or telephone number ("personal information");
- that is about you but individually does not identify you; and/or
- about your Internet connection, the equipment you use to access the Website and usage details.

We collect this information:

- Directly from you when you provide it to us and
- Automatically as you navigate through the Website. Information collected automatically may include usage details, IP addresses and information collected through cookies.

Information You Provide to Us. The information we collect on or through the Website may include:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on the Website. This includes information provided

at the time of registering to use the Website and information you input to generate a Prescription, including case notes. We may also ask you for information when you request assistance in using the Website or report a problem with the Website.

- Records and copies of your correspondence (including e-mail addresses), if you contact us.
- Your responses to surveys that we might ask you to complete for research purposes.

If you are a registered user, you also may provide information, such as case notes or other information, to be published or displayed (hereinafter, "posted") on the Website, or transmitted to other registered users of the Website or third parties (collectively, "User Contributions"). Your User Contributions are posted on and transmitted to others at your own risk. Although you may request us to set certain privacy settings for such information (e.g. limiting access to registered users associated with a specific medical practice), please be aware that no security measures are perfect or impenetrable. Additionally, we cannot control the actions of other users of the Website with whom you may choose to share your User Contributions. Therefore, we cannot and do not guarantee that your User Contributions will not be viewed by unauthorized persons. You should also be aware that if you elect to share a case with another registered user of this Website, an unencrypted email will be sent to such user with your case name in the subject line of the email. Such user will, however, be required to login to the Website before viewing additional details of the case you have shared.

Usage Details, IP Addresses and Cookies.

As you navigate through and interact with the Website, we may automatically collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions and patterns, including:

- Details of your visits to the Website, including server log files and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on the Website and
- Information about your computer and Internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, browser type, browser version, and pages visited.

The information we collect is statistical data and does not identify any individual. It helps us to improve the Website and to deliver a better and more personalized service by enabling us to:

- Estimate our audience size and usage patterns;
- Store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize the Website according to your usage of the Website;
- Speed up your searches; and
- Recognize you when you return to the Website.

The technologies we use to improve your experience with the Website may include:

- Cookies (or browser cookies). A cookie is a small file placed on the hard drive of your computer. You may refuse to accept browser cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access or use certain parts of the Website. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you direct your browser to the Website.

HOW WE USE YOUR INFORMATION

- We use information that we collect about you or that you provide to us, including any personal information:

- To present the Website and its contents to you;
- To generate Schedules for the treatment of patients with our products;
- To provide you with information, products, or services that you request from us;
- To fulfill any other purpose for which you provide it;
- To provide you with notices about the account, if any, that you have established with us, including expiration and renewal notices;
- To carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us;
- To notify you about changes to the Website, including changes to the Terms of Use (accessible via the Legal Portion of the Website at orthex.net/legal) or this Privacy Policy, or any products or services we offer or provide through it;
- To allow you to participate in interactive features on the Website;
- In any other way we may describe when you provide the information; and
- For any other purpose with your consent.

DISCLOSURE OF YOUR INFORMATION

We may disclose aggregated information about our users and any other information you may provide that does not identify any specific user or individual, without restriction.

Unless prohibited by applicable law or regulation or by a separate agreement between you and us dated after the effective date of this Privacy Policy, we may disclose personal information that we collect or you provide as described in this Privacy Policy:

- To our subsidiaries and affiliates;
- To contractors, service providers and other third parties we use to support our business and who are bound by contractual obligations to keep personal information confidential and use it only for the purposes for which we disclose it to them;
- To a buyer or other successor in the event of a merger, divestiture, restructuring, reorganization, dissolution or other sale or transfer of some or all of the assets of Vilex and/or Orthex, whether as a going concern or as part of bankruptcy, liquidation or similar proceeding, in which personal information held by Vilex and/or Orthex about the Website users is among the assets transferred;
- To fulfill the purpose for which you provide it;
- For any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information; or
- With your consent.

Unless prohibited by applicable law or regulation or by a separate agreement between you and us dated after the effective date of this Privacy Policy, we may also disclose your personal information:

- To comply with any court order, law or legal process, including to respond to any government or regulatory request.
- To enforce or apply our Terms of Use for the Website (accessible via the Legal Portion of the Website at orthex.net/legal) and other agreements, including for billing and collection purposes.

- If we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of Vilex, Orthex, our customers, our registered users, or others.

The Company does not sell data containing personal identifiable information to third parties unless the Company has received specific authorization to do so by individuals whose information is contained in the data and will never disclose your personal identifiable information to third parties for the purposes of allowing them to market to you.

CHOICES ABOUT HOW WE USE AND DISCLOSE YOUR INFORMATION

We strive to provide you with choices regarding the personal information you provide to us. We have created mechanisms to provide you with the following control over your information:

- Cookies. You can set your browser to refuse all or some browser cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent. If you disable or refuse cookies, please note that some parts of this site may then be inaccessible or not function properly.

ACCESSING AND CORRECTING YOUR INFORMATION
